Dear Ed,

May I first compliment your team on putting together a very professional, informative & entertaining publication. It is well known that Line Dancers are not the most popular people in the Country Music arena, so it is satisfying to know that we have a magazine especially dedicated to the followers of Bootscooting. What the other country enthusiasts don't appreciate is that without the Line Dancers support, many, many artists would never get past the first barrier.

However. To the reason for this letter. I recently read in your last magazine (Vol 2 #4) many & varied comments regarding the Tamworth '96 Bootscooting Competitions. Some were kind while others took for granted the enormous amount of effort that goes into staging competitions of that magnitude. Here in Western Australia we are exposed to competitions in very limited amounts with the major competition for this area of Australia being the "Sandgroper Stomp". A competition staged under C.W.D.I. rulings & successfully staged at that. My main reason for writing is that people who continually put down the organizers of competitions such as the "Spirit Of Tamworth" & "Golden Boot" really can't see past the surface of proceedings. As Tamworth was our first ever time both being involved in the Festival & competing, we were amazed at the level of professionalism shown at both of the competitions. The support shown to us by the organizers, the competitors & the public was overwhelming & although there were problems with programming etc....I feel the organizers succeeded where most people would have given up long before. Take the time to think about what it takes to organize & run events of this magnitude. I myself have been teaching here in Australia for 8 years & it still amazes me how we have matured in the last 3 years to get to the professional level achieved. With this in mind we should give support to people who decide to take on such enormous tasks & help with advice where ever it is constructive & not destructive. To Joe & Kath MacManamon as well as Gordon Elliott I take my hat off & congratulate you all for the effort you have given to allow us to have so much fun. To the judges, of which I also was a participant, I take my hat off to you, for the time & effort you donated out of your busy schedules, not to mention the dancing time you lost, it may seem an easy job sitting there judging dancers, but it does take an enormous amount of time, concentration & dedication to achieve a final result. If it means that it was a three way win - then that is the result. Judges do not consult each other about each act as this would

interfere with achieving a fair & final result.

I am not getting on my soap box, & yes I do have very definite ideas as to what is acceptable in Line Dancing. But in the 8 years that I have been teaching I have learnt that it takes all kinds to make the line dance flow. It also takes a lot of courage to go that step further in trying to organize gatherings, be it competitions or otherwise, for the many Bootscooters who dance the floors. To everyone we met in Tamworth '96, we thank you for a fantastic time & your friendships, we'll be back next year with more dancers to fill the spots of the ones who find it necessary to complain & throw tantrums by threatening NOT to make the trek next year.

Dear Ed,

Firstly let me set the records straight. I am not a dancer, therefore I can write this letter without any bias. I manage a full time country entertainer who performs on many varied types of shows from theatre style concerts, through to cabarets, festivals & full on dance nights. I travel constantly & come in contact with all types of audiences & situations, therefore I am fully aware & quite concerned about the mixed emotions & unrest about line dancers at various shows.

I fully understand that in a seated concert situation, it can be very disturbing having dancers of any type interfering with the show. This can be easily remedied by the artists, their managers or whoever is in charge of promoting these type of shows. All it takes is a little effort in wording their advertisement material, flyers, etc. in a fashion that is easily understood by everyone. Confusion can cause a lot of unnecessary problems. What I fail to understand is a band or artist complaining about the line dancers at their social nights. These are dance orientated nights & everyone should have equal rights to the dance floor. I have heard it said that when rock & roll first took off they had the same obstacles thrown at them as the line dancers do today. 'They take up too much dance floor', is something I am constantly hearing. Although when a Pride of Erin or Barn Dance is played, the floor usually fills to overflowing & there isn't any objection.

Certainly the line dancers should use floor etiquette at all times but conventional dancers should also show a little dance floor courtesy. Everyone is entitled to enjoy their night out.

I was appalled one night when the line dancers were actually asked to leave the floor by club management, they were soon replaced by some drunken men & women who caused more problems than any line dancer would think possible.

I don't think it's fair that artist's encourage line dancers at their gig's & quite willingly sell their albums to them, only to turn around & bag those same people to their friends & others in the industry.

My observation is that line dancing is a great way to exercise & socialise. There is no age barrier, so it's great for the family unit & also just as appealing for folks on their own. Since the line dance phenomena hit our shores, no one can deny that the country music industry & artists have benefitted in very lucrative ways.

I stood dumbfounded nursing my wounded feelings (not to mention my stomped upon foot) I wondered if I would ever be forgiven or forgotten.

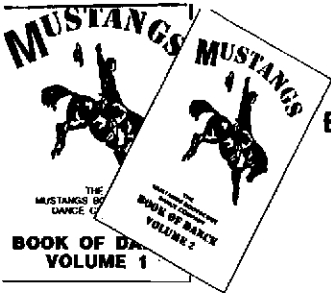
I espied the dancer in question scowling at me several times throughout the night, obviously bearing a grudge, and realised she was far too embittered to return to the dance floor, for she danced no more.

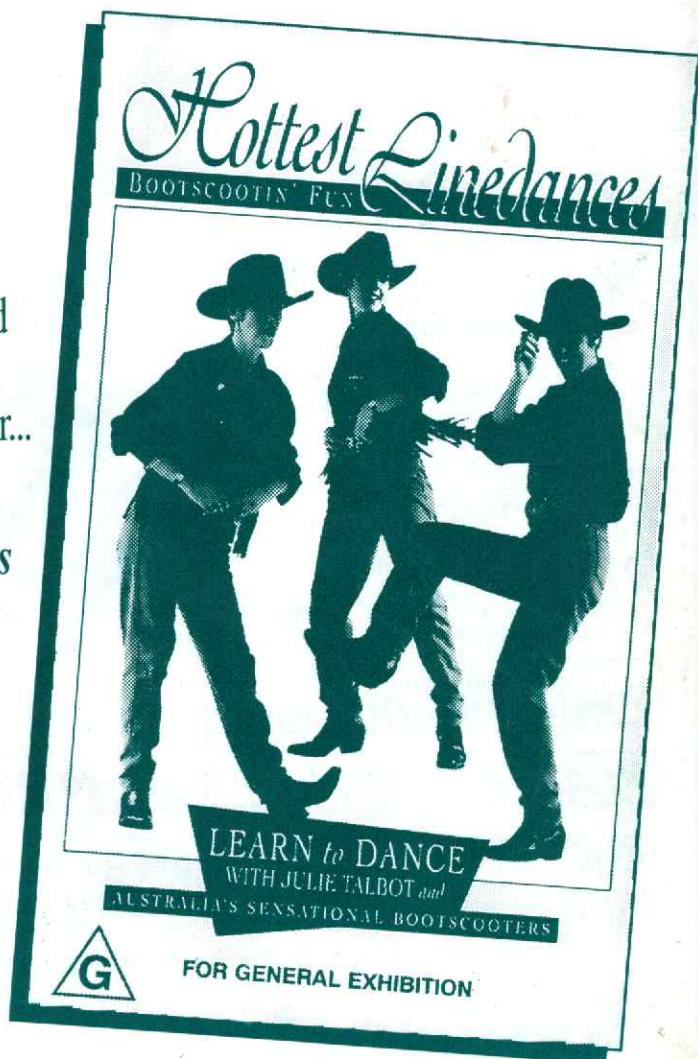
