

Calrossy Auditorium was the venue for the 1996 Line Dancing Championships where the 1,363 contestants almost doubled the 1995 numbers. Co-ordinator Joe MacManamon said he was delighted with the increase "we know around 5,000 line dancers and their families swelled this years festival attendance". Line dancing has up to 70 thousand dancers across the continent and the 1997 festival will add even more to the popular Australian Country Celebration" he said.

The Tamworth Boot, a hand crafted sculpture made from the finest New England timbers, was presented to the 15 title holders in the various sections. They also received gold, and runners up medals. The winners are as follows -

Yee Ha - Howdy Doody Cowboys and gals....I'm the **Computer Chip Cowboy** ! Let me frieze up to the corral and tie my Laptop to the hitching post so I can tell you the very latest info from all over the world via, da dah.. **The Internet** !

Yep, computers are right now helping to form the future of the whole world, let alone the world of **Country Western & Line Dance**, For Example did you know that with one quick "touch heel forward, step together", I can correspond almost anywhere on the planet !

In this little patch each issue I'll be keeping you in touch with some of the very latest decisions regarding **Country Western & Line Dance** like where they are doing it, how they are doing it and why they are doing it. We'll give you the latest dance trends as well as some useful info that may help you in your pursuit of becoming the "**Perfect Line Dancer**". Here's a few "chips" of info.....

If you had ever thought that sometimes its hard to get to the lessons every week because of the rain or heat, let me tell you that in January this year it has been **minus 30** (yes -30) in some areas of the **USA** and some dancers still drive up to 150 miles through heavy snow to get to their lessons !

When some of the **leading** Line Dance choreographers in the **USA** create a dance for a song on a new album, that dance cannot be released by the choreographer until the song is released as a single, sometimes many months after the dance was written.

Because it takes a long while for a new dance to get to dancers all across the world, sometimes the record companies have already deleted the CD with the original song on it. Up to now this has caused a lot of frustration with people trying to find a certain song so that they can do the dance. If they couldn't find the songs, they wouldn't do the dance ! It has now been accepted that whilst the choreographer may have written the dance to a certain song, dancers all over the world are attaching dances to whatever song that fits, they may like a the time and they have access to. For Example, in my little saddle bag I have over 2,000 dance titles from all over the world, with some dances having more than 20 songs attached to them.



What's Been Happening

One snippet of information that somehow buried itself at the bottom of our basket & lay undiscovered for quite a while was this little piece.

The North Coast Primary School Line Dancing Festival was held for the first time at Alstonville on Sunday 29th October 1995 & organised by Jan Macks and Libby Went from Alstonville Primary School, two dedicated line dancers from Lennox Liners Dance Club. Such was the response to the festival, the programme had to be extended from 3 to 6 hours. Over 60 Duo's and teams entered from schools as far away as Copmanhurst, Wooli and Toowoomba, with the children stealing everyone's hearts. This North Coast Festival should prove to be a very popular event on the line dancing calendar. Organisers were delighted when Colleen Maunsell, leading line dance teacher and judge from Brisbane agreed to act as one of the judges along with Marj Holley from Lennox Liners and Beryl Britley from Lismore Lariets. Colleen has just coached 2 teams to wins in the New Zealand Masters & her expertise and experience proved extremely valuable. Nick from Bootscooters Australia also attended and presented the awards.



When out and about around the Central Coast area head on out to the Old Sydney Town Woolshed for their Bootscootin' Nights with live music. It all begins on the 16th February and then happens each 1st and 3rd Friday of every month thereafter with Dianne and Bruce Joseph. Dianne and Bruce are great advocates of splitting the dance floor into 2, so that everyone can dance all night - not just the experienced dancers. Past experience has shown Dianne that 2 dances being done to the same song works well as it gives the beginners the opportunity of practicing the dances they know, so they don't have to sit down and watch while the more challenging dances are being danced. 



Well this was **not** fulfilled & what resulted was a series of lines in one section of Tamworth & many would be dancers could either **not** join in or were crowded out of it. There was **no official count** & the figure of just under **2,900** was the result of dividing the money kindly contributed by the dancers, by 2. Joe Mac Manamon tells us that conversation with many around the continent has resulted in the following; There will be a **LONG LINE** in Tamworth 1997. It will be managed & marshalled by Line Dancers from designated clubs, & dancers will be able to make a community donation. The Line **will** be a *continuous* one & it will be a simple matter of dancers proceeding to both ends of the line.

You have probably been told that accommodation is always in short supply in Tamworth & this is usually true, however with much of Tamworth this year opened up to campers, a place to call home was within everyone's reach. But who would ever have guessed in a million years that the rain gods would choose that particular week alone to re-enact the events surrounding the story of Noah's Ark & send everyone scurrying for higher ground. With much of the flooding taking place at the same time as the Line Dancing heats, competitors had to be reshuffled as police invaded Calrossy urging those dancers with campsites alongside the river to quickly pack up their belongings amidst a full scale evacuation. Not since 1984 had floodwaters created such devastation in the New England area, with stock drowning in the saleyards at nearby Willow Tree, homes & shops flooded & rail lines cut. For those trying to get into Tamworth (or out), the New England Hwy just a half an hour out of town, was cut in two as flood waters wreaked their havoc. And to give you some kind of understanding on just how many visitors invaded Tamworth, it was estimated that at one stage over 15,000 mobile phones helped jam the mobile system!





If the singer / songwriter / musician, took the time out to open their eyes they would see that line dancers can only serve to enhance the sales of their products thus raising their own public profile. I know your magazine gets out to most record companies as I have a good friend who works for one of the *more major* companies, who tells me your publication is read quite discreetly (*discreetly, I don't know why but maybe a quick scout around the more glossy mags would show that there is a lot of incestuous back slapping going on!*)






Luis & Jessica Win

In the **ACLDC** they received gold medals for the Under 12 Duo, Under 16 Duo, Small Group and Large Group. This was after they won the Under 16 Duo and came second in the Under 12 Duo in the **Golden Boot**. Competition in the **ACLDC** was fierce with more than 1,000 entries over all categories from Australia and New Zealand.

Luis, who turned 13 in Tamworth the day after the **ACLDC**, and Jessica, 10, have only been dancing together for around six months. When competing, they dance with a group called the **Breakaway Bootscooters**.

Luis was roped into line dancing some four years ago by his grandmother, Audrey, who wanted all of her nine grandchildren to learn how to do it. Back then he did not want to dance at all, but now does all types of dancing, including **Tap**, **Modern** and **Afro**, just about every day. He wants to compete in the USA and eventually set up his own dance studio there. But in order to do so he needs a sponsor. Someone like Wrangler or Coca Cola.



Jessica has only been line dancing for around 15 months and is already choreographing her own dances. She choreographed one called **Outlive Me**, which she and Luis did at Tamworth. One of the things she really enjoys about competing is travelling all around the countryside, seeing different places and meeting new people. Luis and Jessica recently gave a demonstration of one of their prize-winning dances at Stocklands Mall in Merrylands to help launch the new **ABC CD, Line Dancing Especially for Kids**


